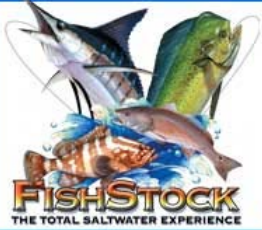

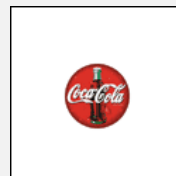
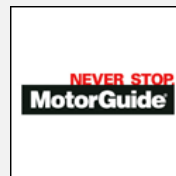

The 5th Annual FishStock festival presented by Sport Fishing Magazine finished on a high note on Sunday, with a record 137 boats competing in Day 2 of the 5th Annual New Smyrna Redfish-Trout Challenge, and thousands of anglers and their families enjoying the sights and sounds of the FishStock Village.

After all the fish were weighed-in Sunday for the Redfish-Trout Challenge, it was Dave Brown & Eugene Futch that took the Ranger Boats Top Overall Boat Award, with a total weight of 47.86 lbs. The Sport Fishing Lady Angler Award went to Judy Thomas, with a 7.16-pound trout, and our MotorGuide Young Angler Award was taken by Danielle Cox, with a 6.72-pound trout.

Unfortunately, the tournament committee early Sunday decided that fishing in the 31st Annual New Smyrna Beach/Daytona Beach Striker Tournament presented by Trophy Boats had to be cancelled for the weekend, due to unfavorable sea conditions. The committee will announce alternate plans, and no one seemed to mind being kept in from the high winds and six-foot seas.

The landside weather was fantastic, however, and everyone turned out to give FishStock 2007 a great send-off. While waiting for the inshore tournament weigh-ins, attendees checked out the Boat Show, a variety of vendor booths, KidStock and great fishing seminars. - Using a secondary compound to remove scratches and restore gloss. Varga will use a high-speed buffer for compound applications, while at the same time prepping and polishing smaller, hard-to-reach areas by hand.
- Washing and drying the boat a second time and applying a final polishing compound and coat of wax to bring out the boat's original gelcoat luster.

"I can't wait to see the results after they detail my boat," says Mr. Robert Bilbrey, owner of the Sundancer. "It's going to be great to watch while they take this old boat and make it practically brand new!"

Experts will be on hand during the demonstration to answer any questions you may have about applying their professional detailing techniques to your own craft.

Attention all Striker anglers:

May 11, 2007- National Marine Fisheries Service (NMFS) has issued a temporary suspension of the circle hook law requirements for Atlantic fishing tournaments targeting billfish through December 31, 2007.

Based on this ruling this year's Striker tournament will allow all State and Federal legal recreational hook types and not enforce the circle hook rule.



Circle hook requirements will be reinstated on January 1, 2008. A copy of the NMFS circle hook law suspension is attached for your review.

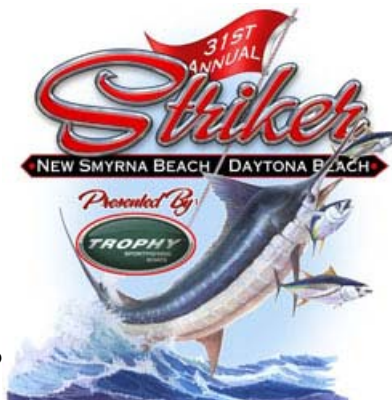
